Details: Admission is paid for by BBC Men's Ministry. You are encouraged to bring your own ammo and guns (see FT3's website for specific limitations). Ammo is NOT provided. We are asking that you bring a box of 9mm or .22 LR (45 mm might be an option as well...TBD). Casey and Mark have a few guns that people can shoot but more will be needed.

As an option, you can rent guns from the range. The range sells ammo as well. If you bring a shotgun you will be required by the range to purchase shotgun ammo that is sold by FT3 (these are the only rounds you are allowed to shoot there).
