In general, the basic idea behind the church camping experience is simple. The church is responsible for making the reservations for the group site and campers are responsible for their own transportation, food, gear, activities, and park entrance fee.

**Cost:** \$13 per person for the entire week (checks payable to Beach Bible Church or cash)

**Other things to be aware of:** The sites are unimproved. No more than 2 RVs/trailers can be accommodated at each group site (no RV hook-ups available). The church has a limited supply of tents and stoves that can be loaned out if requested.
