The church is responsible for making the reservations for the group site and campers are responsible for their own transportation, food, gear, activities, and park entrance fee.

Cost: \$13 per person for the entire week (checks payable to Beach Bible Church or cash)

Other things to be aware of: The sites are unimproved. No more than 2 RVs/trailers can be accommodated at each group site (no RV hook-ups available). The church has a limited supply of tents and stoves that can be loaned out if requested.
