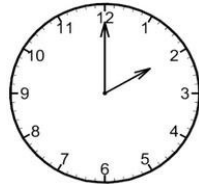
MEXICALI MISSIONS 2017 CHRISTMAS SHOEBOX GIFTS

Christmas Shoebox Gifts

On page 1, Dave Heinz explained the Christmas Shoebox Gifts project our church has been involved in for several years. Following is some of the information included in the instructional sheets available in the lobby. You can help in this project and the process is easy!

Simply decide if you prefer to give a gift to a boy, girl, or woman. If either a boy or a girl, decide what age. Then let Dave or Kathy Heinz know who you intend to build a gift for. This will help assure that we have enough gifts for all ages. Also, if you are not sure who to build a gift for, just ask them. Then have fun and build your shoebox gift and bring it to the Beach Bible Church sanctuary foyer between November 19 and December 13. There are no limitations to how many boxes you can donate.

Boy

Please label your box as **boy** and approximate **age** range.

Shoe box size gift boxes are recommended but any size is welcomed.

School supplies such as pens, pencils, sharpeners, erasers, crayons, markers, stamps, ink-pads, writing-pads, paper, solar-calculators, stickers, coloring books and kids books.

Toys like small cars, balls, stuffed animals, kazoo, harmonica, yo-yo, jump-rope, mini Etch-a-Sketch, light-up-toys, batteries for toys, slinky, etc...

Other fun things such as t-shirts, socks, ball-caps, sunglasses, watches, flashlights w/extra batteries.

Girl

Please label your box as **girl** and approximate **age** range.

Shoebox size gift boxes are recommended but any size is welcomed. Christmas gift bags are also acceptable as long as they are about the same size as a shoebox.

School supplies -- same as listed above under "boy".

Toys such as dolls, balls, stuffed animals, kazoo, harmonica, yo-yo, jump rope, mini Etch-a-Sketch, light-up-toys, batteries for toys, slinky, etc...

Other fun things such as t-shirts, hair-clips, socks, toy-jewelry, sunglasses, watches, flashlights w/extra batteries.

Woman

Please label your box as **woman**.

Shoebox size gift boxes are recommended but any size is welcomed.

Perfumes, hand-creams, bath-towels, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, watches, cups, tea, coffee, eye-glasses, sunglasses.

What not to give

Do not give used or damaged items, medications, money, aerosols, breakable or fragile items.

Do not give war-related items (such as toy guns, toy knives or military figures).

Do not give food items, chocolate, out-of-date candy

This year we are asking that you do not include soap, tooth brushes, and tooth paste in the gift packages. If you would like to donate these items, it would be better to give them to Dave or Kathy for delivery to the daycare center.
